dnstk-cli

Description

dnstk-cli is a command line tool for making DNS queries using dnstk.

Usage

```
dnstk-cli [-h] [-t] [-r RESOURCE] [-c CLS] [-s SERVER] name
```

Optional arguments

-h, --help	show this help message and exit
-t, --tcp	
-r RESOURCE, --resource RESOURCE	
-c CLS, --cls CLS	
-s SERVER, --server SERVER	

Examples

Producing an AAAA query

```
$ dnstk-cli irc.darkscience.net -r AAAA
Response code: 0
Question section
irc.darkscience.net    IN    AAAA
```

```
Answer section
irc.darkscience.net    IN  CNAME      irc.darkscience.ws
irc.darkscience.ws     IN  AAAA       2a02:2770::21a:4aff:fecl:1628
```

Producing a query with a specific server

```
$ dnstk-cli -s 208.67.222.222 ddg.gg
Response code: 0
Question section
ddg.gg IN A

Answer section
ddg.gg IN A 208.94.146.80
ddg.gg IN A 208.94.146.81
ddg.gg IN A 208.94.146.70
ddg.gg IN A 208.94.146.71
```
